EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT (October 2025)

I am providing a wrap up of major events that have taken place in the last year within the Wisconsin National Guard Enlisted Association (WNGEA) and a list of upcoming important dates to remember. It has been a busy and eventful year for the Association.

The 2025 Wisconsin National Guard (WING) Conference:

The 2025 Officer and Enlisted Conference and Professional Development was held at the Double Tree by Hilton on 26-28 April 2025. It was hosted by the 115th FW and Volk Field.
